

Turnkey Upgrade for Mac mini: Packing Tips

IMPORTANT: PLEASE READ ENTIRE DOCUMENT

Data Backup

Any time you send a computer in for service there is an opportunity for data loss to occur. While this is not anticipated, always having a current backup is a great practice. Please ensure that your data is backed up before shipping your Mac mini to Other World Computing.

Packaging

- Please follow the steps provided to help protect the Mac mini.
- Please pack ONLY the Mac mini in the box. Power adapters and other cables are not required to perform this upgrade.
- Please eject any optical discs from the Mac mini; they are not required. Other World Computing cannot guarantee the return of optical discs.
- 1. Remove the top piece of foam. This will reveal a mini-shaped foam cutout and bubble bag (shown below).



2. Place the Mac mini in the bubble bag, then peal back the adhesive strip and seal the bag.



3. Tuck the excess bubble wrap under the Mac mini, then set it inside the cut-out so it sits flush with the top of the foam.



4. Set the foam piece that you removed in Step 1, over the Mac mini.



5. Seal the box with packing tape, then affix the shipping label provided by Other World Computing or your chosen carrier (label not shown).
